



COVID 19 Vaccinations

for 16 & 17-year-olds via UM Shore Medical Center Systems

COVID 19 vaccination appointments will be available for 16 and 17-year-olds through the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center during the weeks of 4/12/21 and 4/19/21, with additional dates being added each week on a rolling basis. The **Pfizer** vaccine which is approved for use in this age group will be offered.

Completing the form does not create an appointment. Once it is your turn and an appointment is available, you will receive an email or phone call with further information about how to schedule an appointment.

You will be able to select from nine locations available in Maryland. The three Eastern Shore locations are below.

- Chesapeake College (Wye Mills, MD)
- UM Shore Medical Center at Dorchester (Cambridge, MD)
- UM Shore Medical Center at Easton (Cadmus Lane, Easton, MD)

You will receive a text and an email to schedule an appointment after you register with the link provided above.

At this time, UMMS policy requires that 16 and 17-year-olds be accompanied by their parent/guardian.
