

QACPS Student Quarantine Guidelines

Student Close Contact Definition

A- If NOT wearing a mask, someone within 6 feet of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period, with or without symptoms.

B- If wearing a mask, within 3 feet or less of an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period, with or without symptoms.

Quarantine

Quarantine if you have been in deemed close contact with someone who has COVID-19, unless you have been fully vaccinated. People who are fully vaccinated do NOT need to quarantine after contact with someone who had COVID-19 unless they have symptoms. However, it is recommended fully vaccinated people get tested 3-5 days after their exposure, even if they don't have symptoms and wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until their test result is negative.

Quarantine vs. Isolation

- You quarantine when you **might** have been exposed to the virus.
- You isolate yourself when you **have been infected** with the virus, even if you don't have symptoms.
