InfoSnap

Once again you will need to update your information in our database by completing the 2021-2022 Back to School Forms within InfoSnap. Summer Learning and Credit Recovery Opportunities

Beginning in June 2021, Queen Anne's County Public Schools will offer instructional learning summer programs for all students in high school. The programs are designed to help bridge learning gaps that may have occurred during the COVID-19 school closures and virtual learning during the 2020-2021 school year.

The first program, [Exact Path](#) is a digital learning platform that has been available to all students in grades 9-12 since Summer 2020 and will continue to be accessible for Summer 2021. The program focuses on the areas of reading, language arts, and mathematics and is individualized to meet the specific needs of each student. Exact Path is an online program that requires the use of a computer.

The second program, [Courseware](#), is also available for all students in high school and allows each student to access online, content-specific curricular units in English/language arts, science, mathematics, social studies, world languages, and Career and Technology Education. These units are designed to reinforce specific content covered during the 2020-2021 school year. Also, all students will have the opportunity to complete an online SAT preparation course

if they choose to participate. More information is forthcoming regarding how to access this program.

Edmentum Custom Courses: June 9-June 30

QACPS High School students will be given the opportunity to recover credits from this school year for courses they did not pass. Interested students will complete an Edmentum Custom Course to recover credits for the 20-21 school year. Students will have from June 10-June 30 complete the online recovery courses, and cannot be enrolled in more than one recovery course at a time. Please note, if a student successfully completes the online custom course, they will receive course credit and earn a Pass for the recovery course, which will not impact their GPA. If your student is interested in recovering a 2020-201 credit, [please complete the attached form](#) by Wednesday, June 9th. Courses will be available from June 10-June 30.
