Class Schedules Go Live August 13th – Complete Your InfoSnap Registration Today!

Please remember to complete your Back to School Forms by logging into the InfoSnap program. Power School will not be accessible (nor will schedules) if your student's Back to School Registration has not been completed. Throughout the summer, e-mails have been sent by the Board of Ed containing a direct link to the form. Additionally, if you wish to enter your student's snapcode manually, a link is available at the bottom of our county's website labeled "Back to School Forms & Registration." Both English and Spanish versions are available.

PARKING PERMIT MEETINGS
