NHS students will be available to tutor in all subjects every Tuesday after school in the Media Center. Please see the attached flyer for the January schedule, details and contact information.

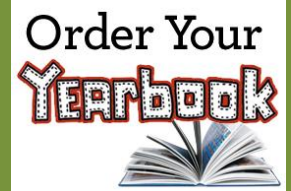
