EARNING CREDITS AND ATTENDANCE

Parents and students are reminded that students who have 5 or more undocumented absences must submit an appeal for their grades in accordance with QACPS attendance policy. Students who receive Credit Withheld (CW) must complete Saturday School or Afterschool Homework sessions to make up the time lost. Failure to do this could result in the permanent loss of credit and retaking the class. If you have concerns in this area contact your counselor.

NEW SCHOLARSHIP FOR SENIORS ATTENDING TOWSON

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS BEGIN

Seniors will want to begin checking Naviance for local scholarships that become available in the new year. There are usually a few each week that become available. Currently available are:

JPK Scholarship: This scholarship is approx. \$30,000 for seniors at QACHS. It is need based and a copy of tax return is required with the application. It has a February deadline. Contact Mr. Willis if you have questions or concerns. **Delegate Steve Arentz** will open his scholarship on Jan. 1st. The application is available. Students should apply to all delegate and senatorial scholarships. These are for in state colleges & universities. Restrictions apply for out of state colleges. **Mid-Shore Scholarship Foundation** has several scholarships available. Student should apply at MSCF.ORG and review scholarships available. These are a few that are now available. More will be coming in the new year.
