This intensive two day training will take place over President's Day weekend. For details, please see the attached flyer.

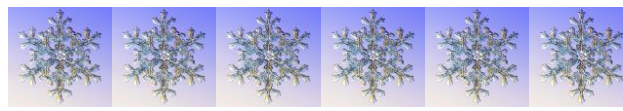
