## Meal Service Programs

August 27, 2020

The Summer Meal Service Program will end on Thursday, August 27, 2020. Three days' worth of meals will be provided that day. Queen Anne's County Public Schools (QACPS) will transition to a more traditional food service program this fall, starting on Monday, Aug. 31, the first day of the 2020-2021 school year. Breakfast and lunch meals will be provided to QACPS students at 5 meal sites.

A student must be enrolled in an QACPS school to receive these meals. This curbside meal service will be provided from 12:00PM – 2:00PM on Mondays only at which point 5 days worth of breakfasts and lunches will be provided. Students/families will need their student identification number in order to pick up a meal. Standard meal prices will be charged and students who receive Free and Reduced-price Meals (FARMS) will continue to pay reduced rates or be exempt from payment. Payment will come from a student's lunch account. Families can pick up meals at any of the 5 sites. The curbside meal service will not be available on Monday, September 7, 2020 as QACPS will be closed for Labor Day. Instead, the curbside meal service will be provided on Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

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If a student will be attending one of the small group instructional programs at their school, a grab and go service will be provided to those students for breakfast and lunch. Students will need their student identification number in order to pick up a meal. Standard meal prices will be charged and students who receive Free and Reduced-price Meals (FARMS) will continue to pay reduced rates or be exempt from payment. Payment will come from a student's lunch account. Students who receive meals from the grab and go service at their school are not eligible to receive meals on Mondays from the curbside meal service program.

QACPS will be providing additional information as we receive it from the United State's Department of Agriculture (USDA) and Maryland State Department of Education (MSDE).
