Project A to Z - Spring Adventure 2021 **Church Hill Elementary School**

Program dates are February 1, 2021 to May 27, 2021

Partnering for Youth is now in its 25th year offering after school programming to the children and families in ten Queen Anne's County Public Schools. At Church Hill Elementary, the after school program is a 21st Century Community Learning Center providing academic assistance, enrichment activities, and family involvement opportunities. This school year is the final year of a 3-year grant. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will begin spring as a remote program, providing your child with a unique after school experience performed in the comfort of your home, then hopefully, as the district moves to reopening the buildings, we will adjust our program to compliment the school day.

We hope you try the remote spring program and hopefully, we'll see your child back at school soon!

Let's go on the PFY Spring Adventure 2021!

We will begin with a 6-week remote program. Then, once the school district opens the buildings, PFY will consider changing the program design to compliment the school day. Stay tuned!

EVERYONE SHOULD COMPLETE THIS REGISTRATION **whether you are returning from the fall program or joining new this spring**

Here's the plan:

- Spring Adventure Kits will be available for pick-up each week.*
- A letter to families and weekly schedules will keep you organized. Each kit will contain daily lessons including: an inspirational message, suggestion for being physically active, and an enrichment activity. Two activities will have projects that let you "travel" different states each week. With the remote program, all the activities/projects will be done at home – any time of the day or night.
- You will receive a suitcase of basic supplies. If you joined us last fall, you already have your suitcase so get it organized and ready to go!
- To see PFY staff and your friends online, join Open Door daily with Google Meets. Join, as often as you wish.
- We'll provide incentives for many activities including the use of Exact Path to encourage ongoing learning. We'll also provide academic support to help with school work if you need it.
- In each kit is a pre-addressed/stamped postcard. To keep receiving kits, complete and return the postcard by mailing it or bringing it to school. This lets us know how you're doing. The postcards will be entered into a grand prize drawing at the end of the spring session.
- We've created a place to email photos of all your masterpieces (projects) and experiences.
- This remote spring program is open to all 1st through 4th grade students who want to have a little fun after school.

*If your child is attending an AA or BB day at school, we will send the kit home with them. Specific days/time for pick up at school will be available soon.

Give the PFY Spring Adventure 2021 a try!

We'll start the spring with a remote program that can be done entirely offline if you wish!

But if you want to join us for online "Open Door" meetings, we'll be there every day to chat, work on projects, and get a little exercise together.
