I hope this helpful hint helps you as you are supporting your children with virtual learning. Thank you for your patience and understanding.


Clever is a secure pipeline between QACPS and the learning applications that your children are using.

Your child has a Gmail account to access Clever, Schoology, Exact Path, and Google Meets. **PREK-2** students only use email to access the platforms.

For all grades K-4, here is a quick way for all students to access these platforms.

- Go to [clever.com](https://clever.com)
- Click “Log in as a student.”
- Find Church Hill Elementary
- Enter your child’s email and password.

Once on Clever, all of the apps your student needs will be there (Schoology, Edmentum-Exact Path, Google Meet).
