

**2021-2022 School Year
Scheduling Help Sheet
THE SOPHOMORE TO JUNIOR YEAR
Guidance Dept.**

All students must have a full schedule in each year. This means everyone will schedule 8 classes and 2 alternates.

All juniors should maintain a balance of academic and pathway classes moving towards graduation. You should maintain or increase the rigor of your program.

ENGLISH: All students must select English III or Honors English III. There are other English electives that may be selected under elective courses if necessary. (English 101 in the Spring of Junior year and English 102 in the Fall of Senior year will meet the English IV requirement)

MATH: All Juniors must take at least one math class.

Option 1: Continue to the next level in your math program.

Note: Advanced Topics of Algebra II – may only be taken as a senior! This is a good review course for students entering a college level math class.

SCIENCE: All students are required to have at least 3 science credits. Review your transcript. If you are a Liberal Studies completer you *may* need 4 science credits.

SOCIAL STUDIES: All students are required to complete American History, Government and World History. If you have not completed these three credits you must select a social studies.

WORLD LANGUAGE: You may continue your progression of world languages. If beginning a language consider two classes. (Fall Spring)

BUSINESS, CTE PATHWAYS & TECHNOLOGY CLASSES. Continue to move your CTE Pathway classes forward. Refer to the Full Course Offering sheet for specific classes within your pathway. Specific pathways; Academy of Health Care Professions, Auto Tech, Carpentry, Masonry require that you complete an application prior to starting these pathways.

FINE ARTS: If you have not completed the one fine art requirement for graduation you should select a fine arts course. All others are considered elective classes.

YEARLONG COURSE SELECTIONS: Please remember you must select two classes from the yearlong selection for each side of the hybrid schedule. (Refer to Full Course offerings Sheet for yearlong classes)

DUAL ENROLLMENT: Only select Dual Enrollment if you are 100% sure you want to take college classes and you have discussed with your parents. Transportation is your responsibility. If you want to but are unsure you can choose this as an alternate. (Students must have a 2.5 GPA to participate.) (Chesapeake offers a 25% discount on tuition)

ALTERNATES: Be sure to select something that you are planning to take as a senior. You could end up seeing this class in your final schedule. Choose wisely.

AP Classes: AP classes are found within the subject areas and electives. Please be sure you are selecting both courses if you are taking yearlong AP classes. Consult the attached sheet for yearlong vs. semester AP classes.
