

**2021-2022 School Year
Scheduling Help Sheet
THE FRESHMAN TO SOPHOMORE YEAR
Guidance Dept.**

All students must have a full schedule in each year. This means everyone will schedule 8 classes and 2 alternates.

As a sophomore you have the opportunity to begin some of our Career Technology Education (CTE) programs. You should also maintain or increase the rigor of your courses.

ENGLISH: All students must select English II or Honors English II. There are other English electives that may be selected under elective courses if necessary.

MATH: All Sophomores must take at least one math class. Continue to the next level in your math program. (If you are unsure which math class is next in your sequence, ask your math teacher or school counselor).

SCIENCE: All students must select either Applied Chemistry, Chemistry or Honors Chemistry.

SOCIAL STUDIES: All students should select Government, Honors Government or AP Government I and AP Government II. Please remember if you choose AP, it is a yearlong 2 credit class, make sure to choose both AP Gov't I and AP Gov't II.

WORLD LANGUAGE: You may continue your progression of world languages. If beginning a language consider two classes. (Fall/Spring)

BUSINESS, CTE PATHWAYS & TECHNOLOGY CLASSES. You can begin some CTE programs. If you are interested in Cosmetology, you **MUST** begin that program as a sophomore. (the Academy of Health Professions/Nursing does **NOT** begin until Junior year). Specific pathways; Academy of Health Care Professions, Auto Tech, Carpentry, Masonry, Welding, Cosmetology require that you complete an application prior to starting these pathways.

FINE ARTS: If you have not completed the one fine art requirement for graduation you should select a fine arts course. All others are considered elective classes.

YEARLONG COURSE SELECTIONS: Please remember you must select two classes from the yearlong selection for each side of the hybrid schedule. (Refer to Full Course offerings Sheet for yearlong classes) Yearlong classes are **NOT** required, however some classes, such as Band, Choir, Theatre are only offered on the hybrid.

ALTERNATES: Be sure to select something that you are interested in. You could end up seeing this class in your final schedule. Choose wisely.

AP Classes: AP classes are found within the subject areas and electives. Please be sure you are selecting both courses if you are taking yearlong AP classes. Consult the course offerings sheet for yearlong vs. semester AP classes.
