I. Purpose:

To implement the administration of Home and Hospital Teaching in Queen Anne's County.

II. Policy Statement:

Queen Anne's County Public Schools will provide instruction to a student registered in a Queen Anne's County Public School who is unable to attend school for a minimum of 10 school days due to a physical or emotional condition as ordered by a licensed physician, licensed psychiatrist, licensed psychologist or certified school psychologist and with the approval of the Superintendent of Schools. Continuation of Home and Hospital Teaching beyond 60 calendar days requires re-verification of service need. Application for services shall be made through the pupil personnel worker assigned to the student's school.

III. Rationale:

Home and Hospital Teaching is designed to provide the home bound or hospitalized student with instruction similar to that received in his/her regular classes so the student is not penalized academically for being unable to attend school. The Home and Hospital Teacher assigned to the student confers regularly with the classroom teacher(s), school counselor, pupil personnel worker and IEP team as appropriate.

IV. Implementation:

The Superintendent shall develop Administrative Procedures to implement this policy.
