I. Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to provide a consistent process for providing opportunities to earn Recovery Credit beyond the normal school day/year.

II. Policy Statement:

Program offering(s) for review credit may be provided beyond the regular school day, based on the determined needs of students.

III. Rationale:

1. Students who are unsuccessful in completing a required course of study will need an opportunity to re-take the class in order to meet graduation requirements.
2. Students are not always able to schedule a re-take of the class during regular school hours.
3. Students may need opportunities to receive assistance toward successful completion of State High School Assessments.

IV. Definitions:

1. Recovery Credit. This is credit received after re-taking a course in an alternative setting, completing required course work, and successfully passing an end of course assessment..
2. Beyond the Normal School Day. This refers to programs which may be offered during summer, or Saturday, or after the normal school day has ended.

V. Implementation:

The Superintendent is responsible for drafting procedural guidelines for the Implementation of this policy.

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VI. Evaluation

The Superintendent will provide the Board of Education a review of this policy in August 2015. The focus of this review will be the effectiveness of the elements of this policy in assisting the Board in fulfilling its mission.
