POLICY/PROCEDURE MANUAL SUMMARY CATEGORY: Personnel Amendment:	

A. Purpose

To establish parameters for the selling or endorsing of instructional materials or equipment.

B. Policy Statement

Certificated employees shall not endorse or sell instructional materials and/or equipment to the children or to the families of the children they teach, or to people in the school community where they live or teach, unless prior approval is obtained from the Director of Curriculum and Instruction.

C. Rationale

To prevent perceived conflicts of interest and/or ethical issues, it is important that teachers and other instructional staff not be seen as promoting, selling or advocating instructional products not vetted and approved by the Board of Education.
