The Eastern Shore of Maryland Educational Consortium (ESMEC) Blended Virtual Program (BVP) is now accepting applications for the 2022-2023 school year. The program is designed to offer families a rigorous, virtual alternative to attending the local school in person for students in grades 6-12.

Queen Anne's County Public Schools is part of ESMEC and is continuing to provide this opportunity for parents to have their children attend this program. If accepted into the program, students will be enrolled in their home school of QACPS, but will receive their instruction through a full day, 5 days per week, blended online platform which will include at least 40% of the time in live sessions.

In an effort to ensure the program is the right fit for students, attendance, grades, online experience, and counselor input (where applicable) will be considered.

APEX/Edmentum is the vendor that will be providing the Maryland certified teachers for each class and all of the curricular materials. Students in the program will be considered QACPS students and will be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities at their home school and must participate in State Testing.

This program is free to families, but students must apply and be accepted.
