EDUCATOR CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to ensure compliance with certification requirements for Maryland Educators.

II. POLICY STATEMENT

Certification shall be as established by the rules and regulations promulgated by the Maryland State Department of Education and COMAR (Code of Maryland Regulations).

Individual educators are responsible for keeping themselves informed about certification as it applies to them.

Certificates are kept in each educator’s file in the local board of education office for the duration of county employment.

III. DEFINITIONS

A. COMAR – Code of Maryland Regulations – the official compilation of all administrative regulations issued by agencies of the state of Maryland.

IV. POLICY ELEMENTS

Queen Anne’s County Public Schools shall comply with COMAR requirements regarding professional education personnel certification requirements.

V. IMPLEMENTATION

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement this policy.


VI. POLICY REVIEW
